Basic Season Information Fall 2008

Game Schedules: Practices can start 8/23/08. First games begin the week of 09/06/08. End of season tournament TENTATIVELY scheduled for Nov 1/2; rain date Nov 8/9.

U5 Nippers should meet prior to their first game to distribute uniforms, game schedules, etc. They do not have weekly practices but they are more than welcome to kick around.

If you need to reschedule a game you MUST contact your commissioner and our Referee Assignor, Brenda Wahlig, IMRefs@WestMontUnitedSoccer.org.

Roster: Your final roster is in your coach's folder. Call your players IMMEDIATELY. If you can't reach someone within week or a player drops out, or any other problems, contact your Commissioner and Joanne Neal, Registrar, at 610.287.2267, registrar@westmontunitedsoccer.org.

Player Changes: Occasionally there may be a player who is unable to play/practice on your scheduled time and requests to change teams. Reassure them we are willing to try to work it out!! Contact your Commissioner.

We can only make a change if an opening exists on another team. Refunds are at the discretion of the Registrar.

Medical Roster: Includes parent information. Pay attention to any allergies/medical issues.

Uniforms: Average uniform sizes were ordered for each team. Distribute by SIZE. Any problems should be reported immediately to your commissioner. If a player drops out they MUST return their uniform.

Referees: Many of our referees are young travel players. Referee is a difficult position for an adult much less a child. Our young referees need encouragement and a little understanding. NEVER talk to the referee during the game. If you have a concern contact Brenda Wahlig

Team Parent: Select a team parent that will take care of the administrative duties. Give them the TEAM PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES handout.

Rain Cancellations: YOU make the decision about practices. Use common sense. Have your team parent help make phone calls. For GAME CANCELLATIONS, the decision will be made by the club, and must be abided by. We'll distribute critical information by email, posting on the website, www.westmontunitedsoccer.org, and an outgoing message on the voice mail at 610.489.9091 one hour prior to game time. Coaches with 8:00/8:30 AM games should call the Field Coordinator or Registrar for immediate updates. We will attempt to reschedule all missed games.
